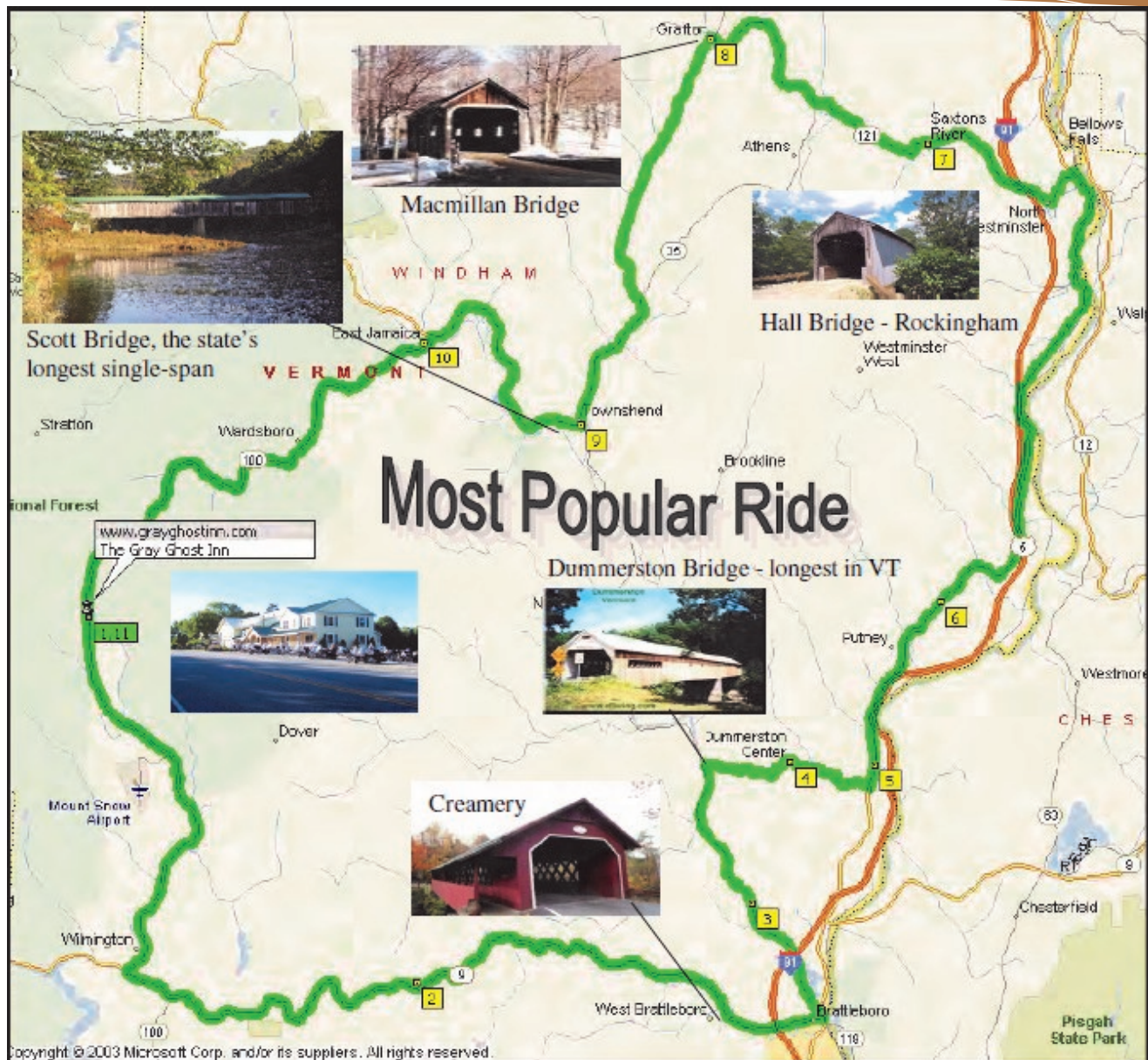

The Covered Bridges and Cheese Ride - 99 miles

No matter how you ride it, clockwise or counterclockwise, this a great ride. Our most popular ride through the years has been the Covered Bridges This route has just the right amount of interesting stops, exceptional scenery, and curvy roads.

Included in this ride is the longest covered bridge in Vermont, 280 feet long, spanning the West River which meanders along Route 30. The Grafton Cheese factory provides an idyllic stop to view the covered bridge as well as a place to see Vermont cheddar being made. Grafton Cheese has a tasting room where you can sample their wares, from freshly made block cheddar to their renowned 6-year-old cheddar.

This ride also includes Hogback Mountain with it's famous 100 mile view, mentioned in most motorcycle books on New England. Just another one of those spots where you can get a great picture of you with your ride!
