Unlike many other B and B's the majority of the rooms have at least two beds each, so singles do not need to share beds. It makes for a great singles retreat, or family gathering. The common area is perfect for casual socializing, and people stayed up late playing board games, watching TV, or sitting by the fireplace. The game room downstairs has Ping-Pong, pool, video games, and another large TV. The hot tub was a hit into the wee hours of morning.

Moreover, I cannot say enough about the innkeeper, Carina. Simply put, she bent over backwards to make her guests happy. After the big snowstorm that hit a few days ago, we all came back to our cars to find that Carina had lifted our wipers up, so they would not freeze to the windshield. We had a stuffed toilet on Saturday, Carina did not just hand me a plunger - she did it herself. Carina drove our guests without cars to the ski rental place a mile away, so they can save money and not have to rent at the mountain.
